CALL FOR ENTRIES - TWO & THREE-DIMENSIONAL ART

- Open to all NAA 2D Media. *All 3D submissions by separate invitation only (tables, pedestal, or gift shop display).*
- Price Cap of \$350 for all works.
- Two Entries Maximum/\$15 per piece, per artist.
- Bin work: 4 matted works per artist. \$3 entry fee for each bin item. All items must be in cello sleeve or plastic wrap.
- Maximum size 40" wide x 60" high or 60" wide x 40" high (size limit **includes** frame).
- All work must be for sale.
- All work must be completed within the last three years.
- Work previously exhibited in one Juried Show but not an Open Show may also be entered.
- All work must be original and conceived by the artist.
- No reproductions. No wet paintings. No Giclees.
- Gallery wrapped canvas must have deep profile stretcher, stapled on back w/gessoed or painted sides.

PLEASE NOTE FRAMING REQUIREMENTS!

- Acceptable hardware for wood frames: screw-eyes or d-rings
- Acceptable hardware for metal frames: hardware that screws secure in track (**not sliding**)
- No saw tooth hangers, spring clips, tension mounts, standing photo frames, or pop-in frames

Important information you need to know:

We strongly encourage you to enter the show online which will make for a much quicker experience during receiving, as well as allow your work to be viewed in our website online gallery and gallery slide show during for the duration of the exhibition.

- Receiving for 2D, Sunday, November 20, 11-5p.m.
- Receptions: Friday, December 2 & 9, 6 to 9p.m. to coincide with Greater Newburyport Chamber of Commerce Holiday Invitation Nights
- Pick-up 2D Work: **Thursday, January 5, 12-6p.m., Friday, January 6, 9-3p.m., and Sunday, January 8, 11a.m.-5p.m.**

Insurance & Artist's Responsibility Works will be handled with all possible care.

NAA provides insurance up to 65% of retail valued declared by the artist, from the day of the receipt of the artwork to the final scheduled pick-up of art work not accepted, work accepted, or delivery of, and payment for, work sold to the buyer. The artist bears all responsibility for loss of, or damage to, work not picked up by the end of the scheduled pick-up period. Artists will be charged \$20 late fee for work left beyond the pick-up period, unless prior arrangements are made with the office. Submission of an entry constitutes agreement with all the terms of the NAA shows. NAA takes a 35% commission on sales. NAA is not responsible for work not removed by pick-up date. Artist grants rights of use of images for publicity and website content. Website thumbnails are protected from enlargement. Please provide notification in advance if someone other than the artist will be picking up the artwork.
