<b>Artist Reception and Awards:</b>	<b>Sunday, March 11, 2-4p.m.</b>
<b>End of show pick-up:</b>	<b>Monday, April 2, 1p.m.-8p.m.</b>
<b>Entries:</b>	Each artist may enter one piece of original art (no tracing, paint by number, art kits, etc.)
<b>Media:</b>	Acrylic, Digital Art, Drawing, Fine Crafts, Mixed Media, Oil, Pastel, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture, and Watercolor
<b>Framing: Very Important!</b>	<b>All Artwork</b> (except sculpture) needs to be framed, wired, and <b>arrive ready to hang</b> . The length of the wire must be at least 5.5” long to be compatible with the NAA hanging system.
<b>Size Limitations:</b>	All work, except sculpture, must not exceed 24” x 36”
<b>Fees:</b>	\$2.00 per entry ~ Registration form may be filled out at receiving ~ Space is limited. Fees waived for NAA Artist and Family members
