



# Hands-on 3D Sculpture

With William Bloomfield

Creating sculptures isn't nearly as complicated as you might imagine! Over 4 interactive sessions, through demos and images, you'll learn a bit of sculptural history, different mediums, methods, and techniques used by 3-D visual artists for thousands of years to make various sculptural forms that we see in museums, galleries, and public art exhibits. We'll initially focus on coming up with all sorts of ideas to create abstract, representational, surrealistic, and contemporary sculptures. During each session participants will execute their ideas using aluminum foil and common, everyday materials. Everyone will receive individual instruction and personal coaching as needed. And there will be a couple of guest artists. The class is limited to 8. Most supplies will be provided.

**About the Instructor** – William Bloomfield has been a stone sculptor for more than 20 years, beginning in his early 30s without knowing anything about carving, and then having set it aside for 20-plus years, picked up his tools again in his 50s. His work tends toward the abstract and he prefers using alabaster, which comes in so many different colors and variations, making every piece a wonderful surprise at the end. He has studied at the Decordova Museum School (MA), The Chautauqua Institution School of Art NY), The Carving Studio (VT), and with Boston-area sculptors.

Bill is a board member and president of New England Sculptors Association, one of the oldest and respected sculptor's organizations in the country. He is also a member of the International Sculptor Center and Concord Art Association. He holds a Ph.D in Social Policy from Brandeis University and consults nationally and globally on youth, education, community and organization development issues. In addition, he is a member of the Screen Actors Guild – American Federation of Television and Radio Artists.
