

Purely Pastels With Robin Thornhill

This 3 week session of pastel classes will be an extension of the Winter Class. We will focus on painting the landscape from photos and concentrate on all of the basics of painting, with an emphasis on understanding

the value scale and how to use it to create different moods in your paintings. Participants will develop several different preliminary value/color studies to guide them through a finished painting.
