


THE DONALD & KIM JOURNEY TRAVELING FELLOWSHIP



The Fellowship provides one grant per year to an emerging or mid-career artist, working in a traditional representational manner, for painting or study in Europe during the year following application. The award to the winning Fellow is \$5000. The painter need not be a landscape painter. The funds in the award are intended to defray costs of travel both to and within Europe, and to help to defray costs of lodging, meals, and art materials, etc.

Application may be made at any time but must be received by December 15th of the year preceding the year of travel. For travel in 2019, applications are due by December 15, 2018. The winner will be notified on February 1, 2019. Travel must be completed between April and October 2019. The winning Fellow will be offered a one-week exhibition, in October of the travel year, at the Newburyport Art Association.

Although there are no restrictions on the Fellow's disbursement of the grant, it is intended and understood that the funds are provided strictly for the use of the Fellow and are not provided to cover expenses for traveling companions. Fellows are reminded, should they not already possess a passport, that applying for a passport and for any necessary visas is the responsibility of the Fellow, who is cautioned that this can be a lengthy process.

Applications are made through the website of the Newburyport Art Association, a 501(c)(3) non-profit entity.

Application Guidelines

Applications for The Donald & Kim Journey Traveling Fellowship will be accepted between September 15 and December 15th of the year prior to the intended year of travel. Travel must take place during the calendar year following the year application is submitted. Applicants must be 21 years or older by December 31st of the travel year. Your application will require:

1. A statement describing how you intend to use the Fellowship (where you intend to travel, what you hope to accomplish in your work, etc.)
2. A digital portfolio, with up to 12 examples of your current work. Each file will need to be uploaded separately, in jpg or png format, with a maximum of 5MG per image. Image file name should be in the following format: title_ artist last name, i.e. Paris Street_Sargent
3. Three letters of reference, from people with knowledge of your work and your ability to use the stipend effectively. Referees must send references **directly** to the NAA, either by email (journeytravelingfellowship@newburyportart.org) or by US mail (Journey Traveling Fellowship, c/o NAA, 65 Water Street, Newburyport, Ma 01950). References submitted through the applicant will not be considered.
4. A summary of your art education. You may also include a CV/resume (optional).

At the time of notification, the winner will be asked to accept or decline the exhibition offer. The successful Fellow will be required to submit a brief narrative of his/her experience while on the the Fellowship and will be required to submit images of the work accomplished during the Fellowship with permission for the Fellowship, and the Newburyport Art Association, to use these images for publicity purposes, etc., to promote the Fellowship.
