He is on the staff of the Photographic Department at Boston's Museum of Fine Arts. His work can be seen in several local galleries and juried shows. He has led photographic workshops in Rockport and Gloucester and an Ipswich workshop for the Trustees of Reservations at the Crane Estate. He is an instructor at the Ipswich Museum's Dow Art Program teaching digital photography and iPhone photography workshops. He is an active member of the NAA and participates regularly in the Association's shows. He is a Castle Hill Artist, showing annually at the Crane Estate Art Show and a Medici Artist showing annually at the School of the Museum of Fine Arts Show.
