Susan's involvement in the arts includes roles as artist, teacher, speaker, writer, designer, and publisher. Her artists' books are in the library collections of the Museum of Modern Art, Wellesley College, Yale University, and Bowdoin College and have been exhibited across the U.S. and Canada and in Korea. She is the author of the independently published *Art Lessons: Reflections From An Artist's Life*, *The Spirit Books* catalog, and *Handmade Books For A Healthy Planet*, and *Multicultural Books To Make and Share*, *Hands-On History: The Middle Ages*, and *Super Pop-Up Reports For American History* from Scholastic Professional Books.
