Barbara London is a musician, artist, writer, and educator. Her long career in the arts has involved leading her own jazz groups , exhibiting her watercolor paintings, producing recordings for her wild aster label, and writing workbooks and poetry. After years of classroom teaching, she became the first female chair at Berklee College of Music in 1994. She left the college in 2005 to focus on her painting and composing. Barbara has a studio at the Salmon Falls Mills in Rollinsford, NH, where she displays her framed watercolors and recordings. As with her musical composition, her art draws from a variety of thematic material including: winter landscapes, semi-abstracted musicians, explorations of science and nature, and whimsical illustrations of her favorite animal, the pig. She has been featured in New England solo exhibitions as well as juried group shows.
