Chris Firger is a professional impressionist painter born in Haverhill, Massachusetts in 1989. He studied at McGill University in Montreal, Quebec and currently works out of his studio in Boston, Massachusetts. Largely self-taught, Chris looks to shed new light on his subject matter through a bold and colorful painting style. Working primarily in acrylics, he is also accomplished in oils and gouache. From landscapes to figures and still life, each of his paintings offers something unexpected that asks the viewer to slow down and consider the scene. Having spent years “north of the border”, much of Chris’s work is influenced by the great Canadian tradition of landscape painting - from the ‘Group of Seven’ to his contemporary favorites in British Columbia and Alberta.
